- A 1. Merida Highway - Motul/Mexico 176 towards Motul.
 - 2. Go past Motul/Take highway 172 towards Telchac Puerto.
 - 3. Take highway Yuc 27 towards Ejido de San Crisanto (1h20 min)
- **B** 1. Merida Highway -Motul/Mexico 176 towards Motul.
 - 2. Go past Motul/ Carretera 172 towards Telchac.
 - 3. Turn right on 21st st / Continue until Sinanché.
- 4. Turn right on 24th st / Continue along the dirt road/ Apiturismo Sinanché will be located at your right.
- C 1. Take Mexico 180 D - Kantunil Highway heading to Valladolid / Chichen Itzá.
 - 2. Go straight for about 3 hrs (passing Valladolid and Chichen Itzá). Yokdzonot will be a town located on your left hand side 20 mins after Chichen Itzá (Cenote is located at the ending side of the town).
